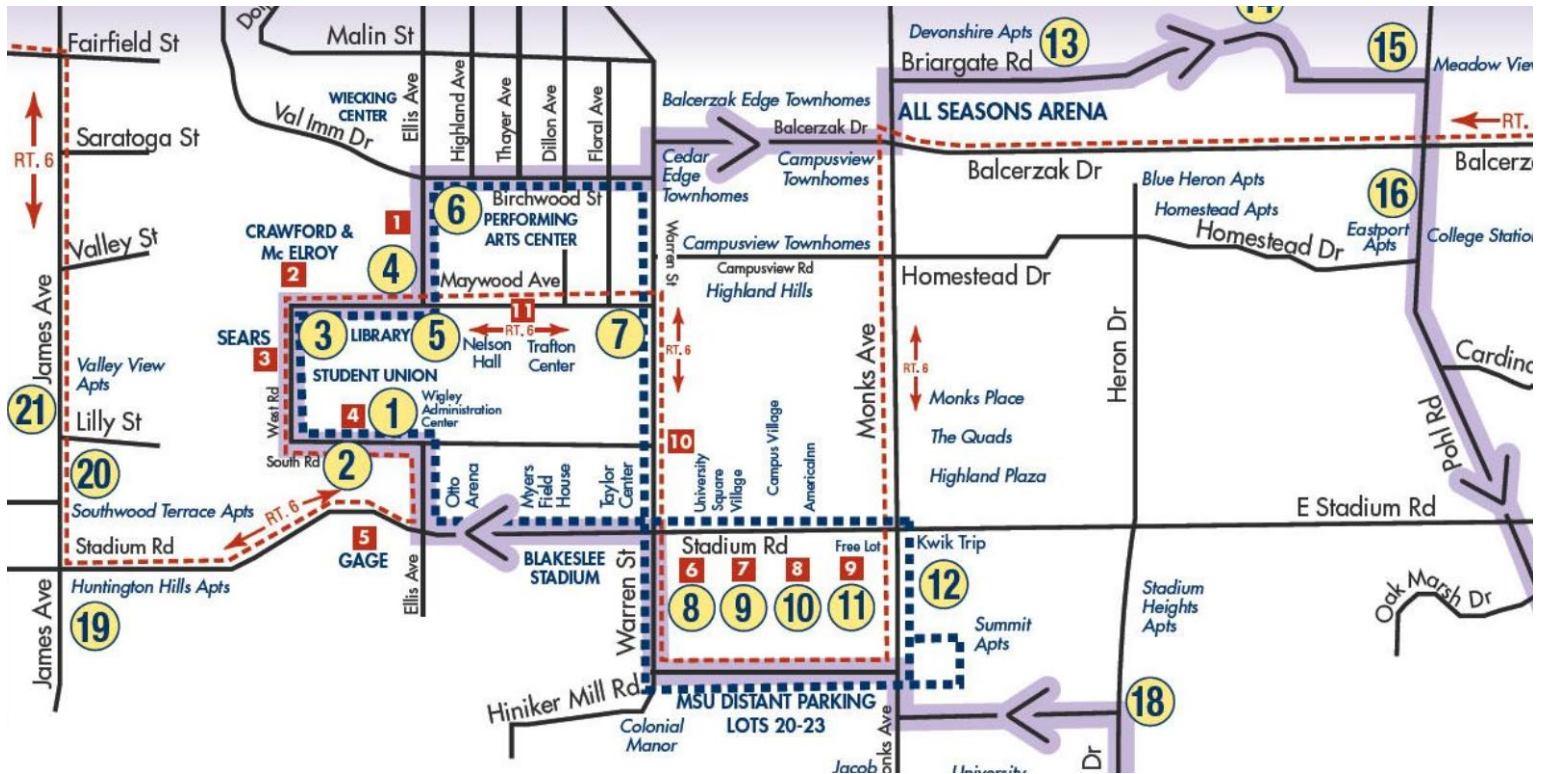


Greater Mankato Transit System
