Future Needs – Buses

Morris Transit currently has six vehicles in its fleet of buses. All six vehicles are class 400, which is a medium-size light-duty transit bus. The buses were acquired between 2009 and 2017, and Morris Transit has programmed the purchase of more buses in 2019, 2021, 2023, and 2025, in accordance with a replacement plan that will replace four of the existing six. All existing buses are in adequate, good, or excellent condition, based on age and current mileage. Morris Transit would also like to obtain an electric bus within five years to enhance sustainability for the City.

Future Needs – Technology

Morris Transit is currently researching dispatching software options to improve the efficiency of transit service communications.
