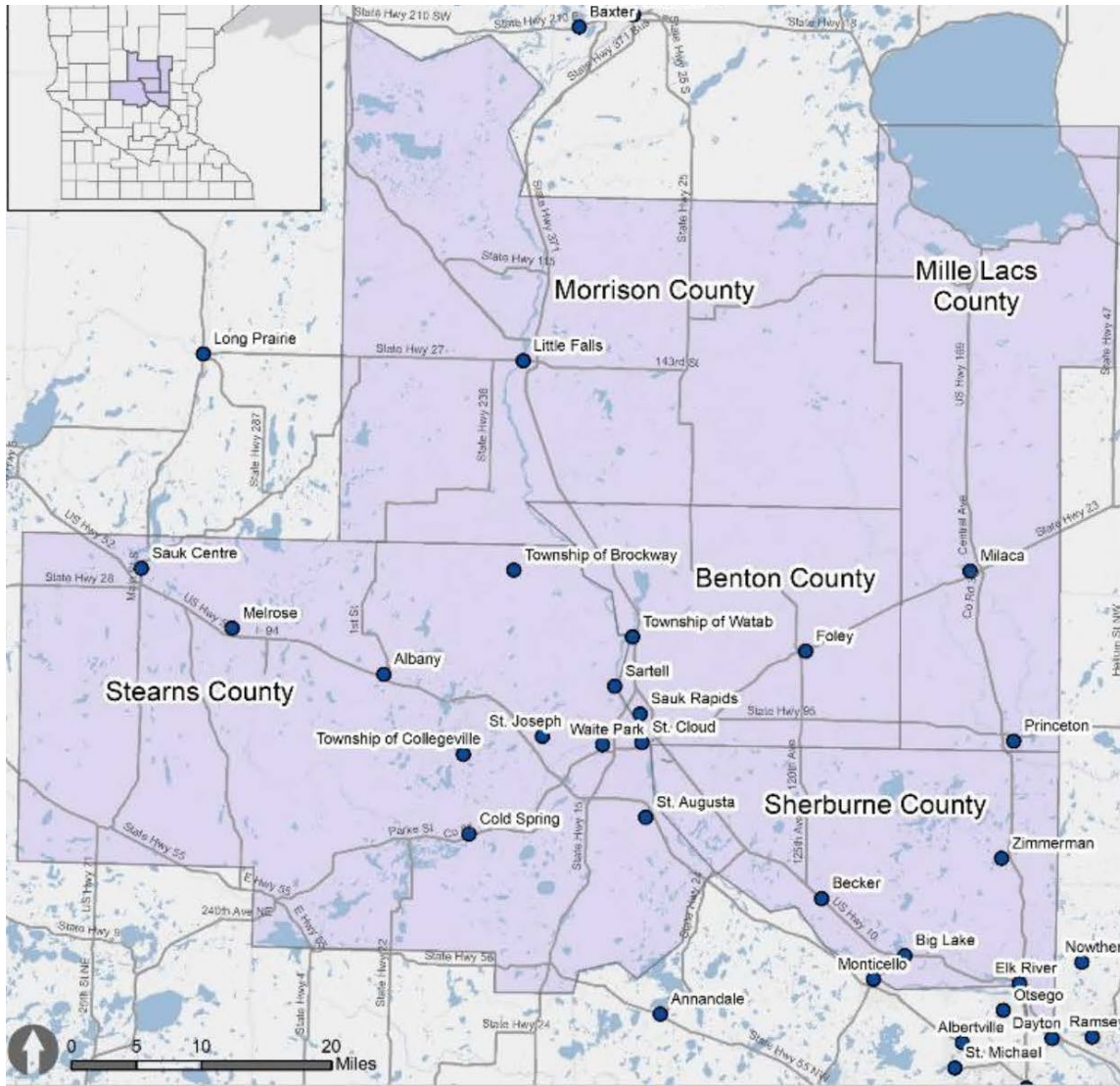


# Tri-CAP Transit Connection

### Agency Background

Tri-CAP Transit Connection is operated by the Tri-County Action Program (Tri-CAP), a non-profit organization based in Waite Park. Established in 1965, Tri-CAP provides transit in Benton, Mille Lacs, Morrison, Sherburne, and Stearns Counties, as well as the cities of Albany, Holdingford, Sauk Centre, Melrose, St. Joseph, Cold Spring, Paynesville, Little Falls, Big Lake, Elk River, Milaca, and Princeton.

## Future Needs – Buses

Tri-CAP Transit Connection currently has 27 buses in its fleet. 11 of these are class 500 vehicles, which are medium-size, medium-duty transit buses. The remaining are class 400 vehicles, which are medium-size, light-duty transit bus. These vehicles were acquired between 2008 and 2018 with new vehicle purchases planned for 2019, 2021, 2023, and 2025. Most of the assets are in excellent or good condition; only four assets are in adequate or marginal condition.
