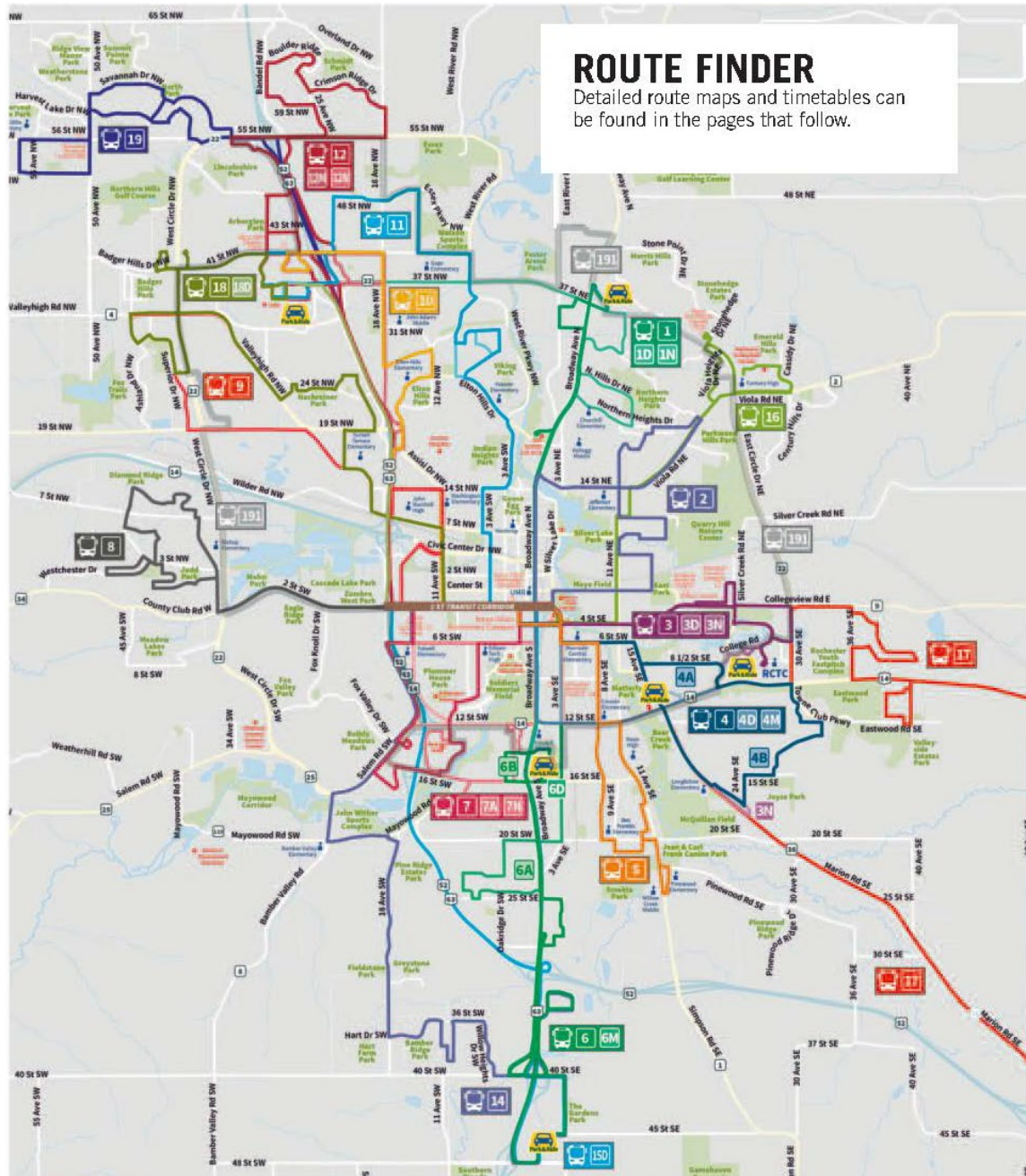


# Rochester Public Transit

RPT owns fifty-one class 700 vehicles and six class 600 vehicles.

**Future Needs – Facilities**

RPT has six park and ride lots located along highways and at Rochester Community and Technical College. RPT also has eight bus stands located along in downtown Rochester.

**Future Needs – Operations**

In May 2017, the City of Rochester adopted the 2017-2022 Transit Development Plan, which will guide RPT as it grows and develops.

RPT uses DoubleMap for real-time bus tracking.
