- Serving Eden Prairie, Chanhassen, Chaska, and Carver.
- Off the shelf scheduling software used to book the rides.


## SW PRIME SERVICE: TIMES & FARES

- ▶ \$4.00 per adult, per ride.
- > \$3.00 for kids between the ages 6 and 12 when accompanied by a paying adult (18 years of age or older).
- ► Free for kids 5 and under when accompanied by a paying adult (18 years of age or older).
- ▶ \$1.00 for seniors on Mondays
- ▶ Free transfers to and from SouthWest Transit express services.
- SW Prime service is available Monday Friday: 6:30 am (First Pickup) 6:30 pm (Last Pick Up)
- Each ride is booked separately, meaning each leg of the trip is considered one ride



### How the big picture works

- SW Prime service region is split into two zones: Eden Prairie and Chanhassen-Chaska-Carver
- Trips that cross zone boundaries are forced to transfer Prime vehicles at SW Village P&R to ensure that 'same zone' trips can be batched together efficiently

### What Makes Prime Efficient?

- Entry level operator wages
- ▶ Technology
  - ▶ Web requests minimizes booking time
  - ► Allows for just one dispatcher to oversee system
  - ► Automatic driver assignment
  - On bus technology that routes trips efficiently as well as allow credit card transactions that speeds up boarding time
- Mid-point transfer to reduce deadhead miles



► Average Ride Time: 13.6 minutes

► Average Wait Time: 18.5 minutes

► Total Rides: 5,550

▶ Denials: 0

► Peak Buses Used: 10
