Commitment to Meeting People's Transit Needs

Transit service is a lifeline for people!
We need to expand service to make transit convenient and accessible for more of the people who need it and are requesting service.



Meeting Needs by 2025

We want to be much closer to meeting the need by 2025

We need a plan to get there or it won't happen



Why 5-Year Plans?

Uncertainty About the Future

Mergers, RTCCs, Performance Measures, one-year contracts



Purpose/Goals

Difficult to Assess Unmet Needs

Not worth bothering to ask, don't have time to deal with it, no local match



Challenges

- Lack of Community Involvement and Support
 - Local officials not engaged, not willing to commit funds or increase funding levels



Challenges

Blanket policies don't work

Across the board performance measures or service levels doesn't work when systems are so different.



Challenges

- Lack of Adequate Staffing/Resources
 - Can't devote time to planning, to marketing campaigns, can't meet future needs without additional staff and assistance through technology.



How to Address these Challenges?

Individual, Tailored 5-Year Plans created by the systems that include a constrained and unconstrained vision including a marketing component with assistance from professional consultants
